In Men's Doubles Xu Xin and Fan Zhendong of China overplayed top seeded Masataka Morizono & Yuya Oshima from Japan -- 4:1.
Liu Shiven and Ding Ning from China won their champions' title on the ITTF WTTC 2017 in Dusseldorf, Germany by defeating a pair from China Chen Meng and Zhu Yuling in a very close match -- 4:3.
In Mixed Doubles competition on this World championship a Japanese pair Maharu Yoshimura and Kasumi Ishikawa won the first Mixed Doubles WTTC Gold medal for their country in 48 years! They made a history in Dusseldorf!
